*Age 3 years or older and have successfully passed a preschool screening


*Must be toilet trained

and Who is Screened?

The public school Screening Team is sponsored by the Southwick-Tolland-Granville Regional School District.

The screening is offered free of charge to all children who are three, four or five years of age and who are residents of Southwick, Tolland or Granville. The Screening is a brief survey of a child's growth in different areas (e.g. readiness skills, speech/language, hearing and vision). You and your child will rotate through several screening centers and your child's results will be mailed home to you.

Why is the Screening Provided?

The screening is part of a federal law which asks public school to offer this service. It is provided for several reasons:

Accredited by the NAEYC Academy for Early Childhood Program Accreditation

- (1) we hope to provide families with information on how a child is developing in relation to other children of similar age
- (2) this is one way to help identify children who may need additional assistance in one of the above developmental areas and then to provide services in this area, and lastly
- (3) it is a prerequisite for enrollment as a peer partner in the Public School's Preschool Program.

Screening Occur?

There are two actual screenings—a preschool screening and a kinder-garten screening. These screenings occur at Woodland School, 80 Powder Mill Road, Southwick, MA.

The <u>preschool screening</u> is scheduled on one designated Friday each month, and then all day on a Friday in January, at Woodland School.

The <u>kindergarten screening</u> occurs in May at Woodland School, as well.
